- 1) You are representing not only yourself, but also your team, coaches and the program at all times. You will always act responsibly and respectfully in and out of uniform.**
 - No drugs, alcohol, use of inappropriate language or behavior unbecoming of a Storm Cheerleader will be tolerated.
 - Profanities or inappropriate representation on online profiles such as “MySpace” will not be tolerated.
 - No display of affection towards boy/girlfriends is acceptable at a team function of any kind.
 - No arguing/ill words or negative attitudes towards teammates or coaches will be accepted.

- 2) All practices and competitions are mandatory. It is impossible to be successful in any team sport without each and every vital member of the team.**
 - If you frequently miss practice or other team events you will be removed from the team and an alternate may be moved in.
 - You must notify Shannon ASAP if you are to miss a practice. If you have a family vacation planned, you must provide notification in writing.
 - You competition schedule is given months in advance, therefore competition absences for any reason will not be allowed.

- 3) Report cards must be shown to your coach each grading period.**
 - All athletes must maintain a “C” average to keep their spot on the team.
 - Suspension from school of any kind will equal dismissal from the team.
 - Any failing grade will equal probation/ and or dismissal from the team.
 - Homework/ and or special projects are NOT excused absences. Part of being a responsible team member is being a good student and part of being a good student is time management.

- 4) Designated Practice Uniforms must be worn as per the calendar.**
 - Day 1- White Shirt with Black Shorts
 - Day 2- Teal Shirt with White Shorts
 - Day 3- Navy Shirt with Gold Shorts

 - White athletic sneakers with white “no-show” socks
 - Hair pulled up with a matching hair tie or ribbon
 - No jewelry, no glitter, minimal make-up
